RULES

- A. All baked goods become the property of the fair.
- B. The following QUANTITIES are REQUIRED:
 - A. Muffins, Cookies, Brownies, Candies; ½ dozen (6)
 - B. Cakes, Bread; ½ loaf or ½ cake
- C. IF THE AMOUNT TO BE TURNED IN FOR JUDGING IS LESS THAN THE REQUIRED AMOUNT, THE ENTRY WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED.
- D. Entry form must list the type of food.
- E. **All food entries must be displayed in zip lock bags; DISHES WILL NOT BE RETURNED TO EXHIBITOR. (Except Pies & Cakes).**
- F. DO NOT put the exhibitor's name on the entry (do NOT label the zip lock bag). The name will be on the entry tag.
