Monday, April 22 thru Wednesday, May 8 4:00 PM at Fair Office	ALL LIVESTOCK ENTRY FORMS DUE – INCLUDING DOG PROJECTS
Wednesday, May 14 ALL DAY	Ownership Deadline for: Breeding Cattle, Show Rabbits, Market Rabbits, Breeding Sheep, Feeder Lambs, Breeding Gilts, Feeder Hogs, Show Birds & Market Birds, Market Turkeys.
Monday, June 3 4:00 PM	Quality Assurance Certificates due – Must be turned in by one Leader or Advisor for entire program (4-H, FFA, Grange & Independent) with cover page listing in alphabetical order all livestock exhibitors included with packet. Leader signatures deadline. Any entry forms submitted that are missing leader signatures, must be signed and fully executed as an “approved entry” document.

NOTE: Please have purchased exhibitor passes, RV passes and Carnival Wristbands Purchase by entry due date (May 8) and picked up before Friday, June 7.

Livestock parking passes will be handed out on Load-in Day, one pass will be given to each family (number of family members or vehicles you own is irrelevant).
