ADULT FINE ARTS

Divisions 40 - 42

PROFESSIONAL EXHIBITORS, DIVISIONS 41 & 42 are for those professional artists who TEACH, SELL regularly, or have gallery shows.

NON-PROFESSIONALS, Divisions 40 & 41 are for those who engage in arts and crafts work as a HOBBY or for the love of the work, whose return from sales, if any, does not exceed the cost of the material for the articles sold and who are not otherwise remunerated on account of engaging in this work, except for cash prizes and Cash Awards.

ADULT RULES

- Entries must be the original work of the exhibitor within **two years** of the opening date of the fair to be eligible for premium awards.
- Entries shown in previous El Dorado County fairs will not be accepted.
- Professional exhibitors are not permitted to enter Division 40.
- Non-Professional exhibitors are not permitted to enter Division 42.
- There is a limit of **two** entries per exhibitor per class.
- All exhibits **MUST BE IN A SUITABLE FRAME/GALLERY WRAP** and ready for hanging with screw eyes and wire, **or they will not be hung.**
- Size of entries is limited to no larger than 36"x48".
- All entries must have a title on the entry form.
- Copyright mark with date of creation is recommended in all works.
- Exhibitor's name shall be printed on the back of the entry. Exhibitor's name should not be exposed on the front of picture. If a name is on the front, please cover with tape.
- Nude studies will not be accepted.
- Exhibits may be sold. A 25% commission will be charged. Entries must be labeled "FOR SALE" and the price indicated on the entry form.
- Insurance desired on any entry must be carried by the exhibitor. The fair will assume no responsibility for any article that is lost, stolen, or damaged.
- No entries will be released without a claim check.
- No entries may be removed during the Fair.
- Unless valid reasons can be proven, no late entries will be accepted.
- STATE RULES APPLY**
- Entries will not be accepted if the above rules are not followed.**

NOTE: Cash award checks WILL NOT be mailed, checks not picked up with entries must be picked up at the fair office during regular fair office hours.

ENTRY FEE: \$3.00 PER ENTRY PER CLASS

A "Best of Show" ribbon will be awarded in each Division.

TEEN RULES

- A. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class and a total of five entries.
- B. Teen Art entries must be mounted on matte board or construction paper. **NO FOAMCORE BOARD**. The fair reserves the right to reject any entry that cannot be hung.
- C. All entries must be the original work of the exhibitor.
- D. **Exhibits must be adequately and correctly labeled on back of work (including name & age & title, if available).**
- E. Exhibitors wishing insurance coverage must arrange for their own insurance.
- F. Overall **dimensions** must not exceed **20" x 24"**. Entries will be disqualified if size is too large.
- G. No frames are allowed on entries; entries may be wrapped in plastic.
- H. The fair will use every precaution within its power for the Safe preservation of all exhibits, but will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.
- I. **Parent, Guardian or Teacher signature is required on entry form**
- J. All judging will be done by the American Standards.

YOUTH ART

YOUTH RULES

- A. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per Exhibitor per class with total of six entries.
- B. The fair requests that all Youth Art be mounted on a matte board or construction paper. The fair reserves the right to reject any Youth Art entry that cannot be hung.
- C. All entries must be the original work of the exhibitor.
- D. **Exhibits must be adequately and correctly labeled on back of work. (Including name & age & title, if available). **School MUST be listed if a group project.****
- E. Exhibitors wishing insurance coverage must arrange for their own insurance.
- F. Overall dimensions must not exceed **12" x 18"**. Entries will be disqualified if size is too large.
- G. No frames are allowed on entries; entries may be wrapped in plastic.
- H. The fair will use every precaution within its power for the safe preservation of all exhibits, but will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.
- I. **Parent, Guardian, or Teachers signature is required on entry form.**
- J. Danish Judging will be used.
