- **\$35.00 per night per RV parking on Fairgrounds**
- **RV Camping with Horses**
  - **\$35.00** per night per RV. No stall rental. No arena usage. May set up own stalls.
  - **\$40.00** per night per RV. No stall rental. Includes arena usage. May set up own stalls.
  - **\$60.00** per night per RV. Includes stall rental and arena usage.
- One extra vehicle allowed at no charge.
- Power and water hookups are available.
- Sewer Hookups are not available.
- Dump station available
  - For RV guests ONLY.
  - Not open to the general public.
  - Charged at \$8.00 per use
  - Available between 7:30 am - 3:00 pm
- Parking for RV's is restricted to assigned areas.
- RV parking is limited to fourteen (14) consecutive days.
- Checkout time is 1:00 pm.
- Quiet time is between 10:00 pm - 7:00 am
- No tent camping without prior permission from Fair Staff.
- Driving off-road vehicles on Fairgrounds is prohibited.
- Association is not responsible for theft or damage incurred to vehicles parked on the Fairgrounds.
- No campfires, open flames or charcoal BBQs allowed. Only propane BBQs please.
- Lost & found items should be turned in to the Fair Office during regular business hours; Monday - Friday 9:00 am - 4:00 pm
- Bicycles, roller blades, skates, scooters, and skateboards are prohibited on the grounds.



- Weapons, including knives and firearms, are prohibited on the grounds.
- Speed limit on the Fairgrounds is 10 MPH
- You will be charged for any hazardous clean-up and/or gas leakage, etc.

  - RV Park
- **No Animals are permitted to roam freely.**
  - Animals must be on a leash (or in RV/Pen) and under owner's control while on Fairgrounds.
  - Persons having animal(s) on the grounds must use every care to assure the safety of all visitors on the Fairgrounds.
  - Owner must clean up after animals.
  - Anyone in violation of this policy will be asked to remove the animal(s) from the grounds.
