#### **RULES**

- A. Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class.
- B. Buffet table settings are NOT acceptable.
- ADULT Classes: A table will be furnished by the Fair Association (3'x3').
- D. Centerpieces may be used, such as flowers, candies, etc.
- E. Displaying the menu is required. A completely typed, printed or written menu on a 5"x7" card must be furnished. Menu may be for breakfast, lunch or dinner.
- F. Linen, placemats, china, glassware and flatware will be furnished by the exhibitor. The Fair Association will take reasonable precautions against theft and damage. All accessories should be marked with the name of the owner, but marking must not show in the exhibit when accessories are in place.
- E. Tables to be set for one place or two in accordance with the chosen setting.
- F. If perishables are used, they must be kept fresh for duration of the fair.
- G. Sterling silver or other valuables must not be used in the setting.
- H. Flatware may be in place for judging but MUST be removed after judging only flatware can be removed after judging. All other items MUST remain.
