**What if you don't want the meat?**

**RESALE** the animal back.... And receive a possible tax benefit!  
How this works.....

If you purchase a 1,200 pound steer for \$3.00 per pound the gross cost would be

**\$3,600**

If you elect to **RESALE** the steer, the "market price" would be subtracted, for example, if the market price is \$1.00 per pound, your credit would be

**\$1,200**

Subtract the difference, and you then now owe

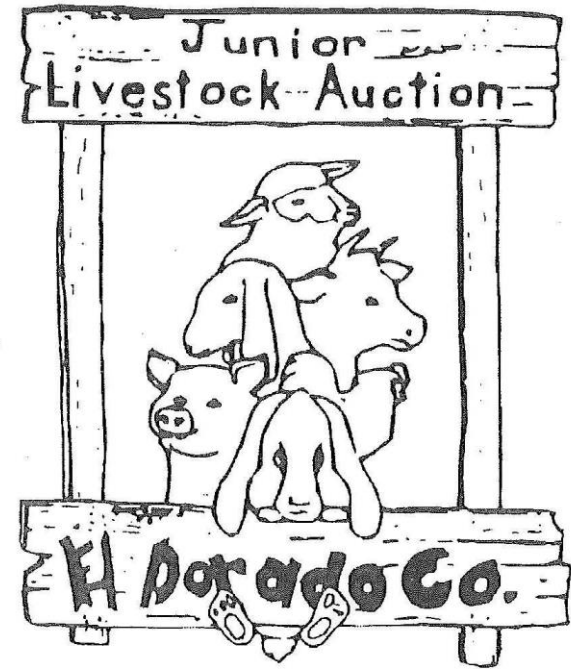
**\$2,400**

**NOTE: YOU ARE NO LONGER GETTING ANY OF THE MEAT IN THIS SCENARIO!**

*Check with a tax consultant regarding the tax deductions for price paid above the market value of an animal.*

You may also donate the meat to a local charity program. Additional information is available at the Registration desk.

NOTE: You will be charged for the processing of the donated meat.

### Beef

A 1200 lb. live weight beef provides about:

720 lbs. of total dressed meat. With a bid of \$3.00/lb., the animal would cost \$3,600. Add about \$500 for processing, and you'd pay \$4,100 or \$3.42/lb.

### Lamb

A 125 lb. lamb provides about:

60 lbs. of total dressed meat. With a bid of \$4.00/lb., the animal would cost \$500. Add about \$60 for processing, and you'd pay \$560 or \$4.48/lb.

### Pork

A 250 lb. swine provides about:

125 lbs. of total dressed meat. With a bid of \$3.50/lb., the animal would cost \$875. Add about \$180 for processing, and you'd pay \$1,055 or \$4.22/lb.

### Tips about Bidding

1. Buy top quality meat for the freezer.
2. Share a purchase by bidding with friends or family.
3. Donate purchase to local service organization or charity.
