ALL GOATS must have their premise identification (tattoos or ear tag) and registration (for Dairy Goats and Nigerian Dwarf Dairy Goats only) on the grounds at all times due to the Scrapies Eradication Program*. To enroll, call 877-741-3690.

RULES

- All stalls must be stripped clean at end of Fair.
- Only animals with a "Certificate of Registry" (blue border) issued for purebred animals are eligible.
- Animals with a "Certificate of Pedigree" (brown border) issued for grade animals are not eligible. Exception: All Recorded Grades Division.
- A photo-copy for registry is not acceptable (original copy OR stamped duplicate only)
- A permanent ear tattoo is required.
- Junior Yearling in milk must be shown with Senior Yearling in milk.
- All animals in "registered purebred breeding animal" divisions must be registered and recorded with a United States breed association in the exact name of the exhibitor (owner) as declared on the entry form.
- All breeding goats must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. The management may demand such proof or ownership as it deems necessary in each case, have papers with you on grounds.
- RECORDED GRADE DAIRY GOATS:** A permanent ear tag or tattoo is required. Animals with a "Certificate of Pedigree" (brown border) issued by the American Dairy Goat Association are eligible EXCEPT ANIMALS IDENTIFIED AS NATIVE ON PERFORMANCE AND NATIVE ON APPEARANCE. Animals with a "Certificate of Registry" (blue border) issued by ADGA are not eligible.
- All sheep and goats from out of state require official individual identification valid for 30 days after inspection of the animals, a certificate of veterinary inspection and a California entry permit within 15 days of entering California.
- All ages are determined as of Show Date.
- ALL GOATS ON GROUNDS MUST BE ENTERED IN A CLASS OR NURSING AND UNDER 4 MONTHS OF AGE.**

NOTE: No refunds will be made for diseased animals.

DIVISION 507 – 4H MARKET GOATS DIVISION 508 – FFA MARKET GOATS CLASS

1. AOB – may be any breed or cross not recognized by AGDA.
2. Owner Bred, this is a class within a class, and you must enter a 4H or FFA Market class to be eligible. 1st through 3rd Place ribbons will be awarded to top 3 “owner bred” market animals.

RULES

1. ALL stalls must be stripped clean at end of Fair.
2. All Market Goats must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 60 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. The management may demand such proof of ownership as it deems necessary in each case.
3. An out-billing from a sales yard must be made out to the exhibitor, showing 60 consecutive days ownership, or a signed statement that the animal was dropped from the exhibitor's doe and raised by the exhibitor or a purchase receipt showing 60 consecutive days ownership.
4. Market goats must have milk teeth in normal positions and no permanent teeth showing at that time. Any goat having lost any of its milk teeth will be disqualified.
5. This show is open to any breed or crossbred female (un-bred) or wether goat. Any animal showing signs of pregnancy or testicular development will be disqualified.
6. Market goats are does and wether, no bucks allowed.
7. Fitting – Goats must be slick shorn with 3/8" hair or less at the time of arrival. Does and whether eligible. Goats must be disbudded. Wether and does from all breed classes will be co-exhibited in the market show classes.
8. After weighing, market goats will be broken into classes by weight for convenience of judging. There will be no minimum or maximum numbers of animals per weight class.

9. Market Goats must weigh a minimum of 60 pounds, goats weighing in excess of 105 pounds will have sale weight adjusted to 105 pounds.
10. Age determined as of show date.

*As a result of the new USDA Scrapie Eradication Program, all goats and sheep entering fairs are required to have individual identification on the animal. The official identification may be official USDA individual identification ear tags, premises ear tags, Scrapie Flock Certification Program ear tags, registration tattoos if accompanied by registration papers, or other methods approved by the California Department of Food and Agriculture including a Premise ID. All goats and sheep from out of state are required to have official individual identification, a certificate of veterinary inspection and a California entry permit.
