

4H, FFA & INDEPENDENT Exhibitors,

Load in will be 6 - 8 AM both days July 10 & 11. (2 lanes on the 10th, one for Beef and one for goats and sheep)

Rabbits will come in through the Fair Lane Gate by Denny's from 9:00 AM - 10:00 AM. They will drop off at the Rabbit Barn and immediately move their car and park behind Barn C, which is the traditional Sheep/Market Goat Barn which is the Barn closest to the Fair Lane Gate. Rabbit Show is a carry-in show and cages will not be provided while on grounds.

Master Showmanship and Livestock Judging exhibitors (that are not already showing an animal on Saturday) will arrive through the Armory Rd Gate (behind Raley's) at 9:00 AM, where they will have their temperature taken and a wristband given to allow access to barns. Parents arriving with them, will also be checked.

All exhibitors and their two parents (No Spectators, no non exhibiting siblings, no grandparents, relatives, friends) will be required to have their temperature taken and asked the standard Covid questions. After passing the temp test, they will get a wristband that shows that they are approved to be on grounds.

There are three barns, please stay within your species barn, if exhibitors have more than one species, they need to be in the barn where they are needed and practice safe social distancing of 6 feet apart from non-family members.

Based on the Governor's recent guidelines, we need to be very diligent at our July shows. Anyone that is not helping, not exhibiting, not working in or outside the rings, etc. those that are just watching at or near the ringside, will need to wear a mask. Advise parents to bring masks. We do not expect the exhibitors to wear a mask while they are handling their animal, they can safely socially distance.

Shavings will not be provided in pens, only the show arenas. Leaders should work with their groups to bring in a bale for each stall.

Because this is a one-day show for most, we are not requiring white jeans, official uniform from the waist up, you may wear dark blue jeans.

Exhibitors may bring in their shavings, tack, chutes, etc. on Thursday between 1:00 - 3:30.

Leaders may come mark goat and sheep pens for exhibitors, July 6-9 - 8:00 AM - 3:30 PM

Stalls need to be cleaned Monday, July 13, 8:00 AM.
