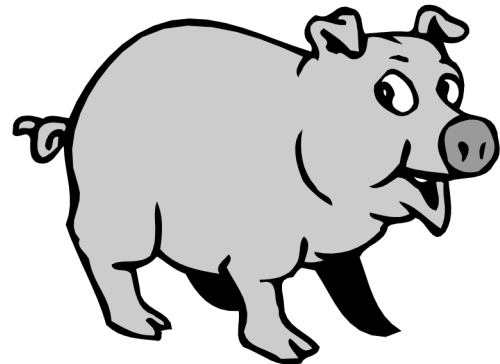

SINGLE MARKET SWINE

ENTRY FEE: \$12 PER ENTRY PER CLASS

- All market swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 60 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. **Proof of ownership must be turned in with entry forms.**
- California brand inspection or an out-billing from a sales yard must be made out to the exhibitor, showing 60 consecutive days ownership, or a signed statement that the animal was farrowed from the exhibitor's swine and raised by the exhibitor.

REGISTERED PUREBRED BREEDING SWINE

ENTRY FEE: \$5 PER ENTRY PER CLASS

- All breeding swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. The management may demand such proof of ownership as it deems necessary in each case.
- Sows must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry.
- Gilts entered in the market or feeder swine classes may not be entered in the breeding class or vice-versa.
- Any violation of these rules will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
- All animals in "registered purebred breeding animal" divisions must be registered and recorded with a United States breed association in the exact name of the exhibitor (owner) as declared on the entry form.
- All Market Swine must be tagged by **Project Leader** no later than Ear Tag Due Date.
- Capping waters or withholding water from hogs will NOT be allowed. This practice may result in expulsion from fair and fairgrounds.**
- New: PAYLEAN – Hogs cannot be sold or processed if they have been fed Paylean. Animals may be tested and rejected at processing plant.**
- No brucellosis or pseudorabies tests are currently required.

1. Market Hogs – 215 to 285 lbs.
(Hogs weighing in excess of 285 pounds will be moved to a Heavy Weight Class)
2. Owner Bred, this is a class within a class, and you must enter 4-H or FFA Market Hogs to qualify for this class.
1st through 3rd Place ribbons will be awarded to top 3 “owner bred” market animals.

NOTE: HOGS WEIGHING OVER 285 POUNDS WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO BE SOLD AT AUCTION

Gilts entered in the market hog classes may not be entered in the breeding classes or vice versa.

SINGLE FEEDER SWINE

ENTRY FEE \$5 PER ENTRY PER CLASS

2 ANIMALS MAXIMUM PER STALL

All feeder swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. Have proof of ownership available if requested.
