RULES

- A. Each Livestock Judge will judge 4 hogs, then 4 cattle, 4 sheep and 4 goats.
- B. Livestock Judges must be at least 13 years old or in High School and must be a 4H, FFA, Grange or Independent livestock exhibitor at this year's El Dorado County Fair to participate.
- C. Tie breakers will first be broken by a written test, then if a tie still exists, it will be awarded based on placings in the following classes in the following orders:
Goats, Sheep, Hogs, Cattle.
