STATE RULES APPLY

- A. All wines other than commercial wines or wines made by a winemaker employed by or owner of a bonded winery are eligible. Must be at least 21 years old.
- B. An entry consists of one (1) bottle (1/5 qt or 750 ml) for judging and display.
- C. Bottle must be labeled as shown with a 2" x 4" gummed label below, in addition to the home/wine maker's label.
- D. Please remove any foil capsules prior to submitting.
- E. Entries become the property of El Dorado County Fair and will not be returned.
- F. All classes will be judged single-blind.
- G. GOLD, SILVER, and BRONZE ribbons will be awarded on the Danish System.
