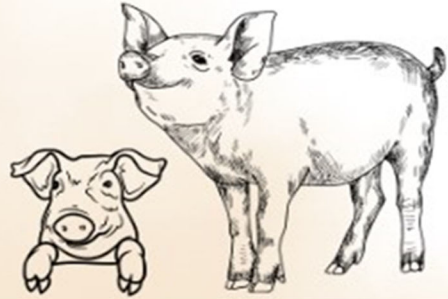

## RULES

- A. All breeding swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. The management may demand such proof of ownership as it deems necessary in each case.
- B. Sows must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry.
- C. Gilts entered in the market or feeder swine classes may not be entered in the breeding class or vice-versa.
- D. Any violation of these rules will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
- E. All animals in "registered purebred breeding animal" divisions must be registered and recorded with a United States breed association in the exact name of the exhibitor (owner) as declared on the entry form. Provide a copy of registration paper with entry form.
- F. **Capping waters or withholding water from hogs will NOT be allowed. This practice may result in expulsion from fairs and fair-grounds.**
- G. **PAYLEAN – Hogs cannot be sold or processed if they have been fed Paylean. Animals may be tested and rejected at the processing plant.**
- H. No brucellosis or pseudorabies tests are currently required.
- I. Health Certificate required for all Breeding Hogs upon entry.

## SINGLE MARKET SWINE

### RULES

- All market swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 60 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. Proof of Ownership must be turned in with Ear Tag forms (April 26, 2023 at the Fair office).
- Bill of Sale must be made out to the exhibitor, showing 60 consecutive days of ownership, or a signed statement that the animal was farrowed from the exhibitor's swine and raised by the exhibitor.
- All Market Swine must be tagged by **Project Leader** no later than Ear Tag Due Date.

**NEW 2023: Prop 12 Documents are required for all Market Hogs and due with Ownership Documents (April 26, 2023 at the Fair office).**

## SINGLE FEEDER SWINE

**ENTRY FEE IS \$6 PER ENTRY PER CLASS**  
**2 ANIMALS MAXIMUM PER STALL**

All feeder swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. Have proof of ownership available if requested.

Gilts entered in the market or feeder hog classes may not be entered in the breeding classes or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.

1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> Place ribbons will be awarded to the top 3 "owner-bred" and "county-bred" market animals.

## LIVESTOCK JUDGING



**Entry forms due by** Monday, May 8, 4:00 pm or midnight online

*At the fair office*

**Judged** Friday, June 16, 3:00 pm

*LIMIT 40 exhibitors, if spaces are available after the deadline, late entries may be accepted through Thursday, June 15, 2023, at 8:00 pm in the Livestock Office.*

### RULES

- Each Livestock Judge will judge 4 hogs, then 4 cattle, 4 sheep, and 4 goats.
- Livestock Judges must be at least 13 years old or in High School and must be a 4-H, FFA, Grange, or Independent livestock exhibitor at this year's El Dorado County Fair to participate.
- Tie breakers will first be broken by a written test, then if a tie still exists, it will be awarded based on placings in the following classes in the following orders: Goats, Sheep, Hogs, Cattle.
