- F. DO NOT put the exhibitor's name on the entry (do NOT label the zip lock bag). The name will be on the entry tag.

DECORATED CAKES

RULES

- A. Decorated cakes of any type, including layer or loaf, that are suitable for special occasions or seasons are eligible.
- B. Decorations must be edible, except for candleholders and figurines. A mix of Styrofoam or cardboard form may be used, provided the shape is one that could reasonably be achieved through baking.
