- Author retains all rights; however, the author must agree that entries may be displayed and used for publicity purposes at the discretion of the fair management.

CLASS

- Short Story

FORMAT: One copy of a short story on 8½" x 11" white paper with each page numbered, titled, TYPED, single-spaced. The story should be between 1000 and 3000 words. The story should be titled.

FORMAT: One copy of each poem on an 8½" x 11" paper, TYPED, double-spaced. Maximum length: 24 lines. Any style, form, or subject is accepted. Booklets are okay. Titled.

- B. **POEM RULES:** The poem must be neatly written or typed using black ink on lined or unlined paper, 8 ½" x 11" white paper. You may create a border to frame your poem, no other illustrations should be added. On the back of the paper, please list your name, grade, school, and teacher, if home-schooled, please list "home-schooled."
- C. **POSTER RULES:** Posters must have a slogan or a title that matches the theme of the poster. On the back of the poster, please write, the name, school, and teacher, if home-schooled, print "homeschooled."
- D. Danish Judging.
