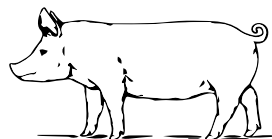

RULES

- All breeding swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. The management may demand such proof of ownership as it deems necessary in each case.
- Sows must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry.
- Gilts entered in the market or feeder swine classes may not be entered in the breeding class or vice-versa.
- Any violation of these rules will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
- All animals in "registered purebred breeding animal" divisions must be registered and recorded with a United States breed association in the exact name of the exhibitor (owner) as declared on the entry form. Provide a copy of registration paper with entry form.
- Capping waters or withholding water from hogs will NOT be allowed. This practice may result in expulsion from fairs and fairgrounds.**
- PAYLEAN – Hogs cannot be sold or processed if they have been fed Paylean. Animals may be tested and rejected at the processing plant.**
- No brucellosis or pseudorabies tests are currently required.
- Health Certificate required for all Breeding Hogs upon entry.

SINGLE MARKET SWINE

RULES

- A. All market swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 60 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. Proof of Ownership must be turned in with Ear Tag forms (April 26, 2023 at the Fair office).
- B. Bill of Sale must be made out to the exhibitor, showing 60 consecutive days of ownership, or a signed statement that the animal was farrowed from the exhibitor's swine and raised by the exhibitor.
- C. All Market Swine must be tagged by **Project Leader** no later than Ear Tag Due Date.

NEW 2023: Prop 12 Documents are required for all Market Hogs and due with Ownership Documents (April 26, 2023 at the Fair office).

CLASS #

1. Market Hogs – 215 to 285 lbs.
(Hogs weighing more than 285 pounds will be moved to a Heavy Weight Class).

NOTE: HOGS WEIGHING OVER 285 POUNDS WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO BE SOLD AT AUCTION.

SINGLE FEEDER SWINE

ENTRY FEE IS \$6 PER ENTRY PER CLASS

2 ANIMALS MAXIMUM PER STALL

All feeder swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. Have proof of ownership available if requested.

CLASS #

1. Heavyweight Hog – 286 +

Gilts entered in the market or feeder hog classes may not be entered in the breeding classes or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.

DIVISION 549 – OTHER MARKET HOGS CLASSES

CLASS #

1. Pen of two market hogs owned and exhibited by the exhibitor.

OWNER/COUNTY BRED HOGS

ENTRY FEE: \$6 PER ENTRY PER CLASS

You must have entered GRANGE, 4-H, or FFA Market Hogs to qualify for these classes.

1st through 3rd Place ribbons will be awarded to the top 3 "owner-bred" and "county-bred" market animals.

AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING

Ribbons Only

DIVISION 551 – OWNER/COUNTY BRED HOGS

CLASS #

1. Owner-bred. Must be Market Ready animal.
2. County-bred. Hog must be born and raised in El Dorado County.

GRANGE, 4-H & FFA GROUPS

NO ENTRY FEE

LOCAL CLASS – NO CASH AWARDS

CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION ROSETTES

RIBBONS TO THIRD PLACE

The class consists of 5 breeding or market animals exhibited in preceding divisions. Animals must be owned by at least 4 different exhibitors from one club or chapter.

DIVISION 550 – CHAPTER OR CLUB GROUP

CLASS #

1. 5 breeding or market animals, at least four (4) exhibitors

Chapters and Clubs are requested to sign- up at the Livestock Office prior to 8:00 AM, the day of the show. No late entries.

STATE RULES APPLY

*** NOTE : All exhibitors selling at auction MUST participate in that SHOWMANSHIP class of species you plan on selling.**
