**PROFESSIONAL EXHIBITORS** are for those professional artists who TEACH, SELL, or have gallery shows. If you are hired to create a piece of art for a client, you are considered a professional.

**SEMI-PROFESSIONALS** are for those who engage in arts and crafts work as a HOBBY or for the love of the work, they may sell some arts, however, do not make their living from the sales. If you have made \$1 or more in art, except for cash prizes, if you attend classes or clinics in art, you are no longer an amateur.

**AMATEURS** are those that treat art as a hobby only. They do not take professional classes; they have never made any money in art, except for cash prizes.

**NOVICE** artists have never won a blue ribbon in any show in art.

#### **ADULT RULES**

- A. Entries must be the original work of the exhibitor within two years of the opening date of the fair to be eligible for prize money.
- B. Entries shown in previous El Dorado County Fairs will not be accepted.
- C. Professional and Semi-Professional entries will be judged together as Division 3.
- D. Entries in any fine arts division may be framed. All entries submitted on canvas or in frames must be ready for hanging with screw eyes and wire or they will not be hung. If no there isn't any backing on artwork (that can have Velcro attached) there must be a hanger attached.
- E. Size of entries is limited to no larger than 36"x48".
- F. All entries must have a title on the entry form.
- G. Copyright mark (©), the year of creation, and the author's name recommended for all creative works.
- H. Exhibitor's name shall be printed on the back of the entry. The exhibitor's name should not be exposed at the front of the picture. If a name is on the front, please cover it with tape.
- Nude studies or unpleasant, non-family-friendly pieces will not be accepted and/or displayed.
- J. Art Sales: If professional or semi-professional artwork is for sale entries must be labeled "FOR SALE" and the price indicated on the entry form. If it is not listed for sale on the entry form and price, it will not be listed. El Dorado County Fair will retain a 20% commission. Sales will be handled through the Fair Office. Sales must occur during Fair & the purchaser must pick up the item on the release date, Monday following the close of Fair. Artists will be paid by check approximately two weeks following the Fair.

NOTE: Sales price may not be changed after the entry form is submitted. Amateur and Novice may not sell artwork.

- K. Insurance desired on any entry must be carried by the exhibitor. The fair will assume no responsibility for any article that is lost, stolen, or damaged.
- L. No entries will be released without a claim check or ID.
- M. No entries may be removed during the Fair.
- N. Classes may be combined to ensure 3 to a class. Prize money will only be paid if there are at least three in a class.
- O. STATE RULES APPLY
- P. Entries will not be accepted if the above rules are not followed.

- D. Exhibits must be adequately and correctly labeled on the back of work (including name, age & title, if available).
- E. Exhibitors wishing for insurance coverage must arrange for their own insurance.
- F. Overall dimensions must not exceed 20" x 24" for Teen Art.
- G. Entries will be disqualified if the size is too large.
- H. Entries may be wrapped in plastic.
- I. The fair will use every precaution within its power for the safe preservation of all exhibits but will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.

Where: Check-in at the Fine Arts Department located in the Organ Room between Noon and 2:00 PM, on Friday of the Fair.

The artist's canvas, paper, board, etc. must be stamped by the art exhibit staff upon check and they can begin painting immediately.

What: Bring your own art supplies and something to transport them; be ready to paint on location, within the Fairgrounds. Size limited to 36x36.

Artwork must be affixed to a firm support board for display on an easel. No matting or framing of art is allowed.

Judging: Artwork to be completed and in the Organ Room by 6 PM for judging.
