RABBITS

ENTRY FEE: \$6 PER ENTRY PER CLASS

RULES (STATE RULES APPLY)

- **A.** Rules, definitions, and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guidebook and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeder's Association, Inc., shall apply to all judging provided they do not conflict with any of the <u>Department of Food and Agriculture</u>.
- B. There is no limit on class and breed entries.
- C. No exhibitor may dictate to management the conditions under which they will exhibit. Pens are assigned by management and are not reserved. ALL BEST-OF-BREED AND BEST OPPOSITE BREED ANIMALS WILL REMAIN FOR THE DURATION OF THE FAIR. **Tattoos will be checked.**
- D. Substitutions may be made only within the same breed, variety, sex, and age (class) as the animal being withdrawn and must be made no later than one hour prior to judging.
- E. All animals must be identified by permanent ear marking matching what is listed on the entry form on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same division must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.
- F. Rabbits will be entered on the standard fair form. Rabbits must be entered by breed, variety, sex, ear number, age and in the correct division and class with the required owner's and leader's signatures to be considered a valid entry.
- G. Animals will be shown and judged only in the proper division and class for the breed, variety, age, and sex.
- H. A judge may eliminate a rabbit from competition because of a temporary or curable defect.
- I. PREGNANT does and does with litters will not be admitted into the show ring.
- J. All rabbits will be fed and cared for by the committee. No locks or hog rings will be permitted on the cages. No "FOR SALE" signs will be allowed on the cages. Failure to comply with any of the above rules will cause an exhibitor to remove his animals.
- K. All rabbits are entered at the owner's risk. Judges and show personnel are not responsible in any way. All reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the rabbits' safety.
- L. Exhibitors will be expected to bring their own rabbits to the judging table. If an exhibitor is busy in another barn, it is his/her responsibility to arrange for another 4-H, Grange, or FFA member to get his/her rabbit to the table.
- M. Rabbits entered in Fur Division must also be in a Breed Division.
- N. Rabbits must be owned by the exhibitor 30 consecutive days prior to the Fair opening.
- O. ANY VIOLATION OF STATE OR LOCAL RULES WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF ANY AWARDS.

- B. Duplication of identification numbers is accepted on animals of different breeds in the Fur Class.
- C. Fur entries must be clearly stated on the entry form.
- D. Absence of ear markings on the entry form will eliminate the animal from the competition.
