**SPECIAL AWARD

Eldest Senior winning a blue ribbon in Needle Arts. To compete for the special award the exhibitor must include the date of birth on the entry form.

Award checks WILL NOT be mailed; checks not picked up with entries must be picked up at the fair office during regular fair office hours.

Classes may be combined to ensure 3 to a class. Awards will only be paid if there are at least three in a class.

RULES (STATE RULES APPLY)

- A. All small pieces, such as doilies, may be securely mounted on cardboard.
- B. Exhibits must be adequately cleaned and blocked.
- C. Items deemed to be offensive or not family friendly will be judged, however, not displayed.
- D. Stained, soiled or unsanitary items will not be accepted.

DIVISION 111 - COUNTED THREAD (Design Size refers to the stitched area; do not include mats or frame when measuring) CLASS#

- 1. Large Framed Picture **Design Size** bigger than 24" in either direction
- 2. Framed Picture Design Size between 12" and 24" in either direction.
- Small Framed Picture Design Size up to 12" in either direction
- 4. Not Framed Pillows, Bell Pulls, Etuis, Wearables, Boxes, Freestanding items, Household items, Christmas Stocking, Christmas Tree Skirt, Christmas Ornament, Christmas Wall Hanging, or any other Holiday, etc.
- 5. Other Counted Techniques Drawn Thread, Pulled Thread, Blackwork, Hardanger; etc.
- **6.** Non-competitive, any above, (specify)

DIVISION 112 – NEEDLEPOINT (Design Size refers to the stitched area; do not include mats or frame when measuring) CLASS#

- 1. Large Framed Picture **Design Size** bigger than 24" in either direction
- 2. Framed Picture Design Size between 12" and 24" in either direction
- 3. Small Framed Picture Design Size up to 12" in either direction
- 4. Not Framed Pillows, Bell Pulls, Etuis, Wearables, Boxes, Freestanding items, Christmas Stocking, Christmas Tree Skirt, Christmas Ornament, Christmas Wall Hanging, or any other Holiday, etc.
- 5. Non-competitive, any above, (specify)

DIVISION 113 – EMBROIDERY CLASS

- 1. Framed items, Boxes
- Not Framed Pillows, Tablecloths, Household items, Bags, Free-standing items, Bell Pulls, Etuis, Wearables, Boxes, Christmas Stocking, Christmas Tree Skirt, Christmas Ornament, Christmas Wall Hanging, or any other Holiday, etc.
- 3. Gold Work, "Or Nue."
- 1. Stump Work
- Other Embroidery Techniques Needle weaving, Cut Work, Mount Mellick, Schwalm, Huck Toweling, hemstitched lines, etc.
- 6. Machine Embroidery
- 7. Non-competitive, any above, (specify)

DIVISION 114 – BEADING CLASS

- Shapes, Wearables, Freestanding, Christmas Ornament, or any other Holiday, etc.
- 2. Framed Item, when over 50% of work is done in beads.
- 3. Non-competitive, any above, (specify)

DIVISION 115 – OTHER FIBER ART CLASS

- Rug Hooking
