RULES (STATE RULES APPLY)

- A. Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class.
- B. Buffet table settings are NOT acceptable.
- C. Half a table will be furnished by the Fair Association (3'x3').
- D. Centerpieces may be used, such as flowers, candies, etc.
- E. Displaying the menu is required. A completely typed, printed or written menu on a 5"x7" card must be furnished. The menu may be for breakfast, lunch, or dinner.
- F. Linen, placemats, China, glassware, and flatware will be furnished by the exhibitor. The Fair Association will take reasonable precautions against theft and damage. All accessories should be marked with the name of the owner, but marking must not show in the exhibit when accessories are in place.
- G. Tables to be set for one place or two in accordance with the chosen setting.
- H. If perishables are used, they must be kept fresh for the duration of the fair.
- I. Sterling silver or other valuables must not be used in the setting.
- J. Flatware may be in place for judging but MUST be removed after judging only flatware can be removed after

judging. All other items MUST remain.

- K. Ideas for Themes:
 - a. Movie Titles
 - b. Book Titles
 - c. TV shows
 - d. Nursery Rhymes
 - e. Disney
 - f. Song Titles
 - g. Cartoon

YOUTH, TEEN & 4-H Additional Rules:

- L. Entrant is to set the table setting independently without adult direction or supervision.
- M. Beginning and intermediate divisions judged using the Danish System. Advanced division judged using the American System.

NOTE: Award checks WILL NOT be mailed; checks not picked up with entries must be picked up at the fair office during regular fair office hours.
